As an integral part of the Mental Health Program, a Proctor 3 will provide services to individuals experiencing multiple needs due to severe mental illness and who require intensive input in order to maintain themselves in the community. Specific goals and activities are identified by the client and the Community Mental Health Worker. The focus of Proctor 3 services will be on providing rehabilitative and crisis supports in the areas of social behavior, life skills, self-care, medication self-administration, coping skills, etc.

- Grade 12 (preferred) with post secondary education in a related field
- One year volunteer/work related experience
- Understanding of client empowerment
- Understanding of the issues faced by individuals experiencing a mental illness
- Knowledge of community resources
- Ability to perform physical and emotional demands of the job
